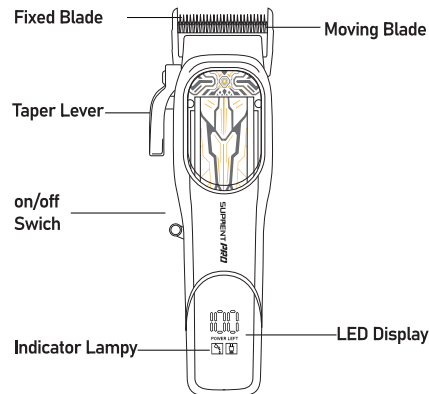

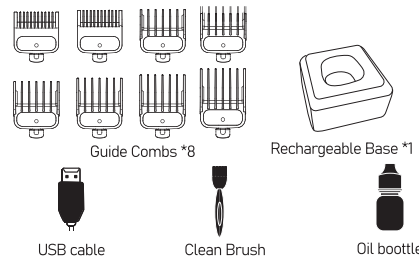

PRECAUTIONS

- (1) Please fully charge the trimmer before first use or after long-term use (please use a power adapter with an input voltage no higher than 5V 1A when charging);
- (2) Before charging, please ensure that the electric clipper switch is in the OFF position;
- (3) Never drop or insert any object into the charging port of the machine;
- (4) Do not operate this equipment if the power cord is damaged or damaged. If it is not working properly or it has been dropped or damaged or dropped into water. Please contact Suprent official customers;
- (5) Keep the power cord away from heating locations;

- (6) Using USB cables not sold by Suprent may cause risks of fire, electric shock or personal injury;
- (7) Do not use it outdoors or operate in places where there are aerosol (spray) products or where oxygen is being used;

CHARGING

- 1) When working, the display is always on and displays the real-time battery percentage ;
- 2) When the battery level is less than 10%, the charging logo flashes;
- 3) When charging: The charging logo is always on, and the real-time battery percentage is swept from bottom to top. When fully charged, the display shows 100, the numbers stop scanning, and the numbers and charging logo remain on.

GUIDE COMB INSTALLATION

Firstly align and secure the top of the guide comb with the blade head, and then snap the bottom of the guide comb into the bottom of the blade head. When disassembling, firstly pull the bottom of the guide comb apart, and then remove the guide comb.



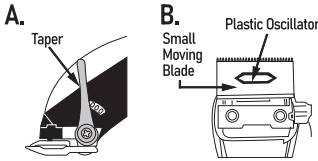
BLADE REPLACEMENT

- 1) Turn off the hair clipper and adjust the taper;
- 2) Remove the screws and retaining blade. Save screws;

- 3) Remove the small movable blade from the plastic oscillator and replace it with a new one;
- 4) Replace the fixed blade using the screws and tighten lightly. As shown in Figure C, adjust the teeth to have a gap of 1/32 in. (1 mm) to 1/16 in. (1.5 mm) with the small moving blade as centered and parallel to the fixed blade's teeth as possible.

Note: The top edge of the stationary knife must be at least 1/32 inch (1 mm) higher than the top edge of the moving knife and as centered as possible. This is important so that the moving blade does not come into contact with the skin. Be sure to add a few drops of lubricant to the blade before operation. After aligning the blades, don't forget to tighten the screws.

ADJUST TAPER

The taper rod on the hair clipper can control the length of the hair style. There are 5

- adjustment levels: 0.8-1.2-1.8-2.4-3.0 mm.
- 1) Slowly push the taper rod downward to obtain longer hair length;
 - 2) Push the tapered rod upward to obtain shorter hair length.

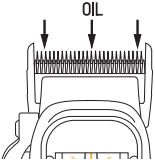
CLEANING

- To maintain optimal performance, equipment should be cleaned after each use.
- 1) Use the provided cleaning brush to clean the remaining hair on the blade;
 - 2) Remove the limiting combs, which can be rinsed under running water to ensure they are completely dry before storage or further use;
 - 3) Oil the blade after each use to ensure optimal cutting performance;
- IMPORTANT: The blade must be cleaned and oiled regularly to function properly, failure to clean and oil the blade regularly will void the warranty, do not rinse the blade

OIL

- For optimal cutting performance, it is highly recommended to oil the blade after each use.
- 1) When using oil for the first time, unscrew the cap and cut off the end of the plastic tube with scissors;
 - 2) Remove the blade guard and open the device;

- 3) Hold the scissors at a 45-degree angle, gently squeeze the oil tube, and then drip lubricant on the blade as shown by the arrow in the figure;
- 4) Leave the device on for a few more seconds to allow the oil to spread thoroughly along the length of the blade;
- 5) Before using on your hair, please turn off the hair clipper and gently wipe it with a dry cloth to remove excess oil.
